
Book Signing Event



- Designed to launch, promote and celebrate author's newly released book
- Suggested places: Hilton, Choice Hotel or establishments' equivalent to, which is closest to you. This usually takes place in a more open area, such as the restaurant in a hotel where traffic walking by is invited to walk-in. The atmosphere is fun and pleasant.
 - Great coffee shops and restaurants will be glad to open their doors to this type of event.
- Suggested amount of time: 2 hours. Half hour program, half hour book signing ceremony and one hour of mingling
- Suggested time: early during the day
- Suggested items to serve: Coffee, water and tea
- Suggestion: Hire a publicist/planner to assist you to do the planning. Launch your book in style.

 Toast and celebrate all the hard work with those who want to be a part of one of your great achievements in life.
- Facility rental fee: + tax and any gratuity if required. In most cases will cover set up and clean up fee, coffee and water station. *Subject to change, depends on location.
- Suggest Admission Price: Book retail price + \$10.00 Admission. Guests can purchase book and/or each sold separately
- Minimum: 25 people
- Suggested to hire booking agent (see publicist section of book for details)
- Marketing Package: sold separately

- Great Suggestion: Author's should ask as many people as possible to have a book club at their homes. The author is the special guest that features their book.
- Most Suggested place: Home (most cost effective)
- Secondary Suggested places: home, sub-division club house, hotel small meeting room or establishments' equivalent to, which is closest to you. This usually takes place in a more closed-in area. read (printers' proofs, copy, etc.) in order to detect and mark errors to be corrected. We will send your guests a proof copy of the book well in advance and ask them to prepare to be entertained as the group goes through the book, page by page. You can invite 5-25 people. The more people, who read, the more eyes will have to give feed back before going public.

Children's Pancake Book Club




Plan your child's next birthday event with adventurous storytellers

BALLIN' OUT





The Order of Melchizedek

Then Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine. He was priest of God Most High, and he blessed Abram, saying, 'Blessed be Abram by God Most High, Creator of heaven and earth. And blessed be God Most High, who delivered your enemies into your hand.' Then Abram gave him a tenth of everything. (Gen 14:18–20)

Abram (whose name was later changed to Abraham) had just returned from defeating four kings and their armies and from rescuing his nephew Lot, whom they had taken captive (Gen 14:1–16). When he returned, Melchizedek brought out bread and wine for him. He then blessed Abram, who gave him a tenth of everything—ie a tenth of the plunder.

Abram's victory had been achieved with the help of God. He and the men of his household had defeated four kings and their armies. Those four kings had previously defeated five other kings, but Abram defeated them with only 318 men.

That was a miracle and was typical of how God helped his people in the Old Testament. Blessed be God Most High, who delivered your enemies into your hand.' It was God who had delivered his enemies to him, and Abram gave Melchizedek a tenth of everything God had given him from that victory.
